ACTION OF BILL REVISING THE POLICY SECTION OF “STUDENT EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTION”

BE IT RESOLVED THAT: Subject to the passage and approval of this bill and its companion procedures bill, the policy portion of the Student Evaluation of Instruction section of the faculty handbook (Chapter 3, Section C10) will be replaced by this bill.

Student Evaluation of Instruction

Policy *Faculty Senate Bill 18-A-4 begins here*

Student evaluation of instruction at Southeast Missouri State University shall be conducted for three distinct purposes:

1. to enable individual faculty members to continually improve the quality of their classroom instruction,
2. to provide individual faculty members with a measure of perceived effectiveness of instruction,
3. to enable students to provide input concerning the quality and content of classroom instruction,

All faculty shall be evaluated by systematic, anonymous student evaluations in all sections of each course taught.
