## **FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 25-6**

## 1 IN SUPPORT OF DIVERSITY, EQUITY, INCLUSION, AND ACCESSIBILITY

- WHEREAS: In Wieman v. Updegraff, 344 U.S. 183 (1952), Justice Frankfurter established the four
- 3 essential freedoms of a university: "to determine for itself on academic grounds who may teach, what
- 4 may be taught, how it shall be taught, and who may be admitted to study," and Frankfurter's opinion was
- 5 upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court in Sweezy v. New Hampshire, 354 U.S. 234 (1957).
- 6 WHEREAS: in Keyishian v. Board of Regents, 385 U.S. 589 (1967), First Amendment protection was
- 7 explicitly extended to academic freedom;
- 8 WHEREAS: the federal and state executive orders calling for the elimination of all diversity, equity,
- 9 inclusion, and accessibility programs is a violation of academic freedom;
- 10 WHEREAS: applying the federal and state executive orders calling for the elimination of all diversity,
- equity, inclusion, and accessibility programs to curriculum is also in direct violation of academic
- 12 freedom;
- WHEREAS: the elimination of all diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility programs is contrary to
- the university's student-centered mission and stated values;
- 15 WHEREAS: the elimination of all diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility programs weakens our
- 16 community and sends a message to historically underrepresented and marginalized groups of people that
- this university does not care about them and will not protect them;
- 18 WHEREAS: the anti-"DEIA" language used by the federal and state government accuses those
- 19 historically underrepresented and marginalized groups of people of being unqualified and asserts that they
- would not earn their place in a supposed "color-blind meritocracy;" and
- 21 **WHEREAS**: compliance with mandates to eliminate diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility efforts
- 22 renders the university complicit in the further marginalization and erasure of underrepresented voices in
- 23 academia:

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- 24 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** Faculty Senate calls on the administration to reverse any actions
- 25 taken to eliminate all diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility programs, including but not limited to:
- 1. Re-opening the equity office and restoring the position Assistant to the President for Equity Initiatives.
- 29 2. Re-opening the LGBTQ+ Resource Center.

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3. Restoring university ties with the LGBTQ+ Employee Alliance and the Black Faculty and Staff Alliance.

4. Restoring faculty control of curriculum in accordance with academic freedom.
